

Your portable emergency toolbox contains basic tools for extracting trapped persons and setting up an expedient emergency camp nearby.

- 1 – 2½lb. halon 1211 fire extinguisher with indicator gage
- 1 – 10in. crescent wrench (*useful for closing a house gas valve*)
- 1 – Long shank narrow flat blade screwdriver (*useful for opening an electrical box*)
- 1 – Diagonal medium duty wire cutter
- 1 – 7in. vicegrip
- 1 – Multipurpose *fireman's* tool (axe/hammer/crowbar combo-tool)
- 1 – Hacksaw with 12in. general purpose blade
- 1 – Compact (folding) shovel
- 1 – Folding *camp* knife, (prying screwdriver/bottle opener, can opener, and awl)
- 1 – 2in. wide X 180ft. long roll of cloth reinforced gaffers tape
- 7 – 15in. long [50lb. test] tie wraps
- 1 – 5/16in. diameter X 50ft. long [375lb. test] solid braided nylon rope
- 6 – 4in. long spike nails, in quart sized slider-ziplock bag
- 12 – 3in. long box nails, in quart sized slider-ziplock bag
- 1 – 6v. lantern battery, krypton bulb floating lantern, and spare bulb
- 4 – 30minute Red highway flares
- 1 – 1¾in. wide X 150ft. long roll of orange vinyl flagging tape
- 1 – Carpenters marking pencil
- 1 – Pair of size 12 work boots (with 3 pair large tube-socks, if needed to enlarge feet)
- 1 – Pair large mens work gloves
- 1 – Over-glasses clear safety goggle
