# Core Maximum Strength non-perscription Medicines

Warning: medicines can induce allergic reactions or produce unwanted side effects, especially in combination. Medication usage suggestions found here are propositions only. Always refer to an applicable medication usage manual.

# 1 - 1oz Liquid **ipecac**

(Emetic)

Drink to induce vomiting of poisons and medicine overdoses from stomach

# 1 – 15g Dehydrated **super activated charcoal in dispenser** [add 4oz water to reconstitute] (Absorbent)

Drink to absorb poisons and medicine overdoses still in stomach

#### Pkg. 12 – 50mg Tablets diphenhydramine hcl.

(Antihistamine)

Induces drowsiness, Reduces allergic reactions to pollen/stings/medicines

# 1 – 16oz Liquid 91% isopropyl alcohol

(Topical antimicrobial / rubefacient) 🕏

Sterilizes medical tools, kills germs on skin, and cools skin by evaporation

# 1 – 1oz Topical ointment 10000iu **polymyxin b sulfate**, 500iu **bacitracin zinc**, 3.5mg **neomycin**, with 10mg **pramoxine hcl.**

(Triple antibiotic with local anesthetic)

Apply to burns and wounds to minimize infection

# 1 - 1oz Liquid **iodine tincture** with applicator

(Antiseptic) 🎗

Apply to cuts to minimize infection

#### 1 − ½oz Oral safe topical ointment 20% **benzocaine**

(Local anesthetic)

Apply to sores in mouth or on body to reduce sensation of pain

#### 1 – 2oz Spirit aromatic ammonia

(Respiratory stimulant)

Inhale to regain consciousness

# Pkg. 16 – 200mg Tablets caffeine

(Metabolism stimulant)

Stimulates metabolism to combat minor concussions

# Pkg. 60 – 500mg Tablets acetaminophen

(Narcotic)

Reduces sensation of pain, eases muscular aches, and lowers fever

# 1 - 2oz Liquid 1mg **loperamide hcl.**

(Anti-diarrheal)

Drink to stop diarrhea or to prevent bowl movement if anal area is burned

#### 1 – 4oz Sterile liquid eye irrigation solution

Flushes contamination out of eyes, sooths irritated eyes

# 1 - Temporary tooth filling and crown cement

Replaces fillings and cements crowns that have been knocked out

# 1 – 1qt Liquid **electrolyte solution**

Drink to combat dehydration that occurs with diarrhea and burns

# **Supplemental Maximum Strength non-prescription Medicines**

Medicines should be stored at room temperature, and replaced before their expiration date.

These common medicines can form an excellent core for a family medicine chest.

#### Dextromethorphan Hydrobromide 15mg (4oz liquid)

Cough suppressant – Drink to suppress the cough reflex.

# Guaifenesin 100mg (4oz liquid)

Expectorant – *Drink to loosen phlegm in the lungs*.

#### **Dyclonine hydrochloride** 0.1% (4oz pump spray)

Oral anesthetic - Apply topically to suppress sensation of pain, especially sore throat pain.

#### Oxymetazoline Hydrochloride 0.05% (1oz pump spray)

Sinodilator – Inhale to reduce swelling of upper respiratory sinus membranes.

#### Ephedrine sulfate 25mg (1oz aerosol)

Bronchodilator – Inhale to reduce swelling of lower respiratory bronchial tubes.

#### **Aspirin** 500mg (70 caplets)

Analgesic – Swallow to thin blood. Reduces headaches, joint pain, and fever.

#### **Hydrocortisone** 1% (1oz ointment)

Itch suppressant – Apply topically to suppress the sensation of itching.

# Dimenhydrinate 50mg (12 tablets)

Antiemetic – Swallow to suppress the vomit reflex. Reduces nausea and dizziness.

# Calcium carbonate 700mg / Magnesium hydroxide 300mg (24 chewable tablets)

Antacid – Chew and swallow to absorb excess stomach acid.

#### Castor oil (2oz liquid)

Stimulant laxative – *Drink to produce bowel movement*.

#### Simethicone 125mg (12 softgels)

Antiflatulent – Swallow to reduce stomach gas discomfort.

# Clotrimazole 1% (½oz ointment)

Fungicide – Apply topically to kill fungus such as athlete's foot, jock itch, and ringworm.

#### Phenazopyridine hydrochloride 95mg (12 tablets)

Urinary analgesic – Swallow to reduce urinary pain and urgency.

# Methyl salicylate 30% / Menthol 10% / Camphor 4% (2oz ointment)

Muscle liniment – Apply topically to relax sore or sprained muscles and ligaments.

#### White petrolatum with Aloe, vitamins A & E, and Oxybenzone spf8 sunscreen (1/3 oz ointment)

Lip balm – Apply topically to moisturize, heal, and protect from exposure chafed lips and skin.
